# Traffic Report for week of **February 12 to 19, 2023.**

*In all construction zones, motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, as well as continue to be cautious of heavy equipment and construction personnel in the area.* <u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Conditions are subject to change without notice. Double fines for speeding in work zones may be in effect.

# Interstates:

# Date St. Business Loop Roundabout Project, T or C CN1101231/3:

La Calerita Construction, LLC. (Contractor) construction on Date, Phase 1 is expected to last about 2 (two) months, through early March 2023, the following traffic impacts will be in place:

**Traffic on North Date Street** will be reduced to one lane each direction (northbound and southbound) and will be shifted to the west (southbound) lanes from north of New School Road to Ash Street. **Local traffic on Smith Street** will be detoured to 9<sup>th</sup> Street. **Local traffic on New School Road** will be detoured to Barton St. Motorists are encouraged to use extra caution in the construction zone, obey lower posted speed limits and allow extra time to reach their destinations. Regular work hours will be 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday-Friday although the contractor may work longer hours or on weekends as needed.

# I-25 Bridge Replacement Project, Williamsburg CN1100900

El Terrero Construction, LLC. (Contractor) will be continuing construction to replace the bridge at I-25 milepost 75, Broadway Street and NM 187 in Williamsburg. The contractor will build two phases of the project, Phase 1 and Phase 5, at the same time. The following traffic impacts will be in place for about one and one-half months, through the **end of February 2023**:

The left lane of I-25 northbound and I-25 southbound will be closed near the bridge so that the contractor can begin building the center pier of the bridge. One lane of traffic will remain open in both directions (northbound and southbound) on I-25.

NM 187 will be closed from Broadway Street to Palomas Circle so that the contractor can build drainage structures. Affected businesses and residents can access I-25 via Exit 71.

Motorists are encouraged to use extra caution in the construction zone, obey lower posted speed limits and allow extra time to reach their destinations. Regular work hours will be 7:30 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday-Friday although the contractor may work longer hours or on weekends as needed. Access will be maintained to all businesses and residences during construction.

# I-25 Guardrail Replacement Project, milepost 102 to 175, Socorro

J-H Supply, Co. (Contractor) will begin a guardrail and end treatment project along I-25 in Socorro County from milepost 102 to 175. Beginning Monday, February 13, 2023, motorists can expect lane closures in the northbound and southbound lanes as the contractor is performing guardrail removal and replacement from milepost 102 to 106. Overnight lane closures should be expected, the contractor will work in three-mile stretches. Hours of operation are from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Construction is expected to be completed by Spring 2024.

# I-10, Mile Marker 55 to 65, Deming CN1101880

Mountain States Construction, Inc. (Contractor) will be continuing the roadway rehabilitation project on Interstate 10 from milepost 55 (Quincy) to milepost 65 (16 miles west of Deming). Drivers can expect various daytime lane closures on both the eastbound and westbound lanes as needed. Contractor's hours of operation will be from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday.

# I-10, Mile Marker 75 to 84, Deming

Mountain States Constructors, Inc. (Contractor), this project is currently on winter suspension, contractor is expected to finish striping March 2023.

#### I-25, Mile Marker 117 & 121, North of Truth or Consequences CN1101580

Hasse Contracting Co. (Contractor) this project is on winter suspension, contractor is expected to be back March 2023.

# <u>US Roadways:</u>

# US 70, Mile Marker 143 to 161, Las Cruces

Mountain States Constructors, Inc. (Contractor) will begin the roadway rehabilitation project on US 70 from milepost 143 (I-10 /US 70 Interchange) to milepost 161 (Organ). Drivers can expect various daytime lane closures on the frontage road and intersections on all eastbound and westbound lanes from Nasa Rd. to Del Rey Blvd. Crews will complete repairs at the <u>Wiesner Rd</u>. intersection which may also impact travel on <u>Balsam Rd</u>. Once complete, crews will move to the intersection of <u>Holman Rd</u> and <u>Dunn Dr</u>. During milling and paving operations lanes will be closed daily for each lane of travel, traffic can travel to the next intersection to turn around. Contractor's hours of operation will be from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

# <u>State Roadways:</u>

# NM 404 Roadway Widening, Anthony to Chaparral

Mountain States Constructors, Inc. (Contractor), will be continuing the roadway reconstruction and lighting project on NM 404 from milepost 0.9 (Anthony) to milepost 8.8 (Chaparral). Drivers can expect various daytime lane closures on both the eastbound and westbound lanes as needed. The contractor will be clearing both sides of the roadway and installing culvert pipe extensions. Paving has begun on the west side of the project for detours. The speed limit has been reduced to 45 MPH during construction hours. Contractor's hours of operation will be from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

# NM 169, Mile Marker 28.58, Alamo

Hasse Contracting Co. (Contractor) will be continuing bridge repairs on NM 169 near milepost 28.58. There is no impact to traffic, and only shoulder work signage in place. Contractors working hours are Monday through Thursday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Construction is estimated to be in place till March 2023.

# NM 404 and I-10 Bridge Replacement, Anthony E100202

AUI, Inc. (Contractor) is continuing with roadwork and replacement of the NM 404 Bridge over I-10 at milepost 162, Anthony exit. Traffic will be switching onto both bridges as needed to finalize the construction project. I-10 may be reduced to one lane only as needed in the eastbound and westbound lanes. Daily contractor hours of operation are from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. Traffic control will remain in place 24/7.

# Frontage Road 1035 "Stern Drive" Mile Marker 5 to 6, Las Cruces

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will have lane closures and shoulder work in place for erosion control measures along Stern Dr. from milepost 5 to 6. A flagging operation will be in place. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and be cautious of personnel and equipment in the area.

# <u>Chip Seal Projects, Hidalgo Co:</u>

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) has completed "Chip Sealing and Brooming" operations in Hidalgo Co. Speed limits will be reduced, no center stripe with loose gravel on roadway. Roadways listed below are scheduled for striping operations in 2023.

- US 70, North of Lordsburg
- Frontage Roads 1007 (Pyramid St. & Airport Rd.)
- 1008 (POW Rd.)
- 1009 (Old Hwy 70)

# City of Las Cruces Projects:

# Sonoma Ranch Boulevard

As part of the Sonoma Ranch Boulevard Mile 1 Construction Project, shoulder work is scheduled on Sonoma Ranch Boulevard, between Sierra Ventana Avenue and Peachtree Hills Road. The shoulder work is expected to last through approximately April 25, 2023. Additionally, a temporary roundabout is in place at the intersection of Sonoma Ranch Boulevard and Engler Road. Motorists are urged to obey all placed warning signs.

# Sonoma Ranch Boulevard

As part of the Sonoma Ranch Boulevard Mile 3 Construction Project, work is scheduled to undergo with roadway and utility improvements by Caliper Construction, LLC on Sonoma Ranch Boulevard, between Arroyo Road and Paseo Verde. Work is estimated to last through approximately February 24, 2023.

#### Walnut Street

As part of the Bike-Pedestrian Infrastructure Improvements Project, work is scheduled to undergo with roadway and utility improvements by Highland Enterprises on Walnut Street, between Hadley and Spruce. Alternating lane shifts will be in place. Work is estimated to last through approximately April 30, 2023.

#### Madrid Avenue

As part of the Bike-Pedestrian Infrastructure Improvements Project, roadway and utility improvements will be done by Highland Enterprises on Madrid Avenue, between Solano Drive and Evelyn Street. Alternating lane shifts will be in place. Work is estimated to last through approximately May 31, 2023.
