Senator Joshua Sanchez Introduces Legislation to Support Youth Game and Fish Programs

SANTA FE – In early February, ten-year-old Braden McIntosh visited the State Capitol with a simple request—to make youth game and fish programs easier to support. **Senator Joshua Sanchez** (R-Veguita) and **Senator Cliff Pirtle** (R-Roswell) were happy to honor his request and together introduced Senate Bill 392. <u>Senate Bill 392</u> would provide an option to round up your purchase of fishing and hunting licenses, game tags, and other game and fish purchases as a donation to youth game and fish programming.

Senator Sanchez issued the following statement regarding Senate Bill 392:

"I want to give all the credit for this proposal to Braden McIntosh who had the courage to approach us with an idea he was passionate about. I know the value of these programs and if we can share that experience with more young people, it will spread a deeper appreciation for our beautiful state. Youth like Braden are the future and I am excited for those who will be served by Braden's great idea."

Senate Bill 392 was referred to the Senate Conservation Committee and the Senate Indian, Rural and Cultural Affairs Committee.
