I-25 Escondida Interchange Study and Public Comment

SOCORRO – The New Mexico Department of Transportation held a virtual public involvement meeting to introduce the I-25 Escondida Interchange Study in Socorro County, NM. If you missed the meeting, it's not too late!

What will this study consider?

The objective of the study is to evaluate the I-25 Escondida Interchange and frontage roads to improve safety, accessibility, and circulation between milepost 151 and 153. Some of the elements evaluated include interchange geometry and condition of the roadway, bridges, and drainage structures, multi-modal accessibility, and the need for frontage road extension over the Nogal Arroyo along I-25 or Escondida Lane.
