More About the Poet Laureate

Archuleta is a native northern New Mexican. *Susto*, his full-length debut collection of poems, published by the University Press of Colorado, is a 2023 Mountain/West Poetry Series title. He is also the author of the chapbook, *Fieldnotes* (Lily Poetry Review & Books, 2023). Most recently his work has appeared in the *New England Review*, *Laurel Review*, *Lily Poetry Review*, *The Cortland Review*, *Guesthouse*, and the "Poem-a-Day" series sponsored by the Academy of American Poets. Born and raised in Santa Fe, he works as a mental health therapist for the New Mexico Corrections Department in Santa Fe County, and lives and writes in the Cochiti Pueblo.
